The Daniel 9 War is Coming to Israel!

The Daniel 9 War is coming to Israel! Now I know what you're saying: 'What is this Daniel 9 War? I've heard of the Ezekiel 38 War and the Psalms 83 War, but not the Daniel 9 War.' And your problem is that you watch the false prophets on YouTube. If you do a YouTube search under Ezekiel 38 War, you will find dozens and dozens of examples. They say the events in the Middle East, are leading up to the Ezekiel 38 War, and that is a lie from the pit of hell.

The Daniel 9 War, precedes those other wars, and it is extremely important for us to understand this. The Daniel 9 War, brings about the Abomination of Desolation. Now, this is my seventh program on the Abomination of Desolation. And so far, we have looked at how the Abomination of Desolation affects the Raptured Protestants, the Protected Catholics, the Holy Martyrs and on this program, how it affects the Converted Jews.

And in each instance, a different individual causes the Abomination of Desolation. For the Raptured Protestants, it was Antiochus Epiphanes; for the Protected Catholics, it is the False Prophet; for the Holy Martyrs, it will be the Antichrist. But who is it, who causes the Abomination of Desolation for Israel and Jerusalem?

And we are going to find out, that Daniel 9 is a warning from the prophet Daniel specifically to Israel and Jerusalem. And how do we know this? Daniel leaves us a very interesting clue: throughout his 12 chapters, Daniel often talks about Israel and Jerusalem; in fact he mentions those two words 16 times. But half of those times, he refers to Jerusalem and Israel in just one chapter and that is, in chapter number 9.

Now I've made a small chart that dramatizes this fact (see below). At the bottom of this chart, I've got the chapters of Daniel listed. At the left, you see the number of instances that the words 'Israel' and 'Jerusalem' are found. And we find that in the first chapter, 'Israel' or 'Jerusalem' is mentioned twice. In chapters 2, 3 and 4, there are no cases in which we find the words 'Jerusalem' or 'Israel'. In chapter number 5, there are two times; chapter number 6, once; chapter 7, zero times, chapter 8, once, but when we come to chapter 9 we find that the words 'Jerusalem' and 'Israel' are found eight times. In chapter number 10, zero times, chapter 11, twice and in chapter 12, zero times again. In other words, the number of times the words 'Jerusalem' and

'Israel' are found in chapter number 9 is equal to the total number of times those words are found in the other 11 chapters of Daniel.

The many false prophets on YouTube will tell you this is just a coincidence, but I'm here to tell you; that is another lie from the pit of hell. The war in Daniel, chapter number 9, is coming to the modern nation of Israel. But who brings about this war? In order to find that out, we need to review the hidden structure of Daniel's chapter number 9, so that we can find out which verses will reveal to us, who this individual is.

Daniel sealed up the prophecies of his last six vision chapters, as directed by the angel, by using hidden or secret verse structures. And I have already explained Daniel 9, but I will just review this very quickly. The first 12 verses are arranged in six pairs; the middle five verses stand apart, and the last ten verses are arranged as five pairs. And Daniel does this to show, that only verses 26 and 27 and 11 and 12 are prophetic verses to the End Times nation of Israel. And two other verses, 16 and 17 are related, but they are not prophecy, they are exhortations, and I will talk about those, later on in the program.

So now let's take a look at these four prophetic verses from chapter number 9, and see if we can find out who it is that causes this war, and the resulting Abomination of Desolation to the modern nation of Israel. Don't forget, the Daniel 9 war precedes the Ezekiel 38 war. Verse number 11: 'Yea, all Israel (now right away we can see that Daniel is addressing the nation of Israel, and because we know this is End Times prophecy, he is talking about the modern nation of Israel) have transgressed your law (they have disobeyed the Torah, the law of God, the law given to them by Moses) even by departing that they might not obey thy voice.'

Do you realize that last year, for example, Israel spent \$88 million to promote Tel Aviv, as the gay capital of Europe? The nation of Israel has lost the blessings of Almighty God; 'Therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that is written in the Law of Moses, the servant of God, because we have sinned against him.' This is a covenant between God and the nation of Israel. But what is this curse? The curse is that Israel would be ruled by her enemies, and Daniel is telling us that this curse is going to come upon the modern nation of Israel.

And verse number 12: 'And he has confirmed his words (when this Daniel 9 war comes to Israel, it will be a confirmation of this covenant) which he spoke against us and against our judges that judged us, by bringing on us a great evil (this is the Daniel 9 war) for under the whole heaven has not been done as has been done on Jerusalem.' Remember, Jesus said that the Great Tribulation will be the worst period of time in the entire history of mankind. And it will be the worst also, for the city of Jerusalem and the nation of Israel.

Verse number 26: 'And after three score and two weeks, shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself'. All of Daniel's great prophecies have both a near time fulfillment and will have an End Times fulfillment. The 62 weeks, in this case referred to 62 years in the End Times, and that date is taken from when Israel was declared a state by the United Nations on November 29th, 1947, and that brings us up to the year 2009. The Messiah, in the near time fulfillment, of course, refers to Our Lord Jesus Christ. But in the End Times, after 2009, the Messiah is the Anointed One, in other words, the King of Israel or, we know him as Benjamin Netanyahu and he will be cut off.

'And the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary (this 'prince that shall come' is the one who causes the Daniel 9 War, and the resulting Abomination of Desolation. The false prophets will tell you this 'prince' refers to the Antichrist, but that is not true, although he is a precursor to the Antichrist) and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and to the end of the war (this is the Daniel 9 War that we are talking about) desolations are determined'. This is the Abomination of Desolation Jesus warned about; and this war in Daniel 9, comes before the war in Ezekiel 38.

Verse number 27: 'And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week.' The false prophets like to tell you that this 'he' refers to the Antichrist, and that he is going to sign some kind of peace treaty with the nation of Israel. This is completely false; it is a lie from the pit of hell. This 'he' can only refer to God Almighty who, I believe, will work through His prophet Elijah. First of all, this covenant is confirmed. That means it is a covenant that is already in existence, and that is the new covenant. And he confirms it with 'many'. Now the 'many' refers to the remnant of Israel, not the entire nation of Israel as we saw back in verse number 11. Nor is it the covenant that is found back in verse number 11, the covenant that will bring the curse upon Israel.

This is the New Covenant, the eternal covenant of Jesus Christ. And He confirms it in one week, that is in the first part of the seven years of the Tribulation and that is the time we are living in today: 'And in the middle of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease.' Who is this 'he'? This is not Our Lord, as we see in the first sentence. This is an entirely new individual. This is the 'prince of the people that shall come'. And it is not unusual for Daniel to introduce an entirely new individual, just with the word 'he'.

'He shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease'; now this sacrifice is not animal sacrifice as proclaimed by the false prophets, because the sacrifice is taken away from the prince, who is Jesus and Jesus never required animal sacrifice. And this occurs in the middle of the week. In other words, in the middle of the seven years of Tribulation: 'And for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate (this is still the prince who will come, the one we are going to determine on this program) even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured on the desolate.' So this war, in Daniel 9, which causes this Abomination of Desolation, continues until the consummation, until the end, and that is when the Ezekiel 38 War occurs.

So in conclusion, we have found out that Daniel hides his prophecies in a secret structure, and that the Abomination of Desolation, and the one who causes that, is different for all four groups who will reign with Jesus during the Millennium. And we've already looked at the False Prophet, Antiochus Epiphanies and the Antichrist, and I believe that the one who causes the Daniel 9 War to come upon the nation of Israel is another new individual. And there is one person in the chapters of Daniel who we have not talked about yet, and that is the 'Prince of Persia', and even though, he is not found in Daniel 9, I can prove to you that he is the one, who is going to bring about the Daniel 9 War very soon. And incidentally, in this month of June, the world is going to be introduced to a new Prince of Persia, and I will talk about that in my next program on this series.
