
How to Pray Mary's Rosary

On this program I want to show you how to pray the Rosary, and I was asked to do this video by the YouTuber, who was formerly known as Megaman2160. He is constantly under attack by the Satanists on YouTube, and he now goes by other titles, but you can look him up if you want to. He also makes videos exposing the evils in our society, and he would like to learn how to pray the Rosary. I don't believe he is a Catholic, but the Rosary is not just for Catholics. And I have here a very large Rosary that was given to me, and this is mainly for demonstration purposes.



And you begin the Rosary, by making the sign of the cross. Then praying the, 'I believe in God the Father Almighty' and so on, in other words the 'Apostles Creed'. You can look up the 'Apostles Creed' yourself on the internet on exactly what words to pray. You pray that on the main crucifix which is part of the Rosary. Now the first bead, in this case, it's a rose, because this is a Rosary made out of roses, and the first bead you pray the 'Our Father', in other words the Lord's Prayer. On the next three beads, you pray 'Hail Mary's'. The 'Hail Mary' is a Biblical prayer. It was first said by God the Father to the Blessed Virgin Mary through his messenger the Archangel Gabriel. In fact it is God's love letter to Mary.

Following these three Hail Mary's, you pray a 'Glory Be'; Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end, amen, and then I add the angels prayer from Fatima; 'O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, and lead all souls to heaven, especially those most in need of thy mercy.' And then you begin the five decades of the Rosary, and you pray according to a certain set of mysteries.

The first set of mysteries are called the Joyful Mysteries, and they include the Annunciation, the Visitation, the Nativity, the Presentation in the Temple and Jesus is lost and found again in the temple. So in the first 10 Hail Marys we will concentrate on the Annunciation; the angel Gabriel announcing to Mary that she is to be the mother of our Saviour. And you begin a decade with the 'Our Father' on this first rose or bead. The next 10 beads, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10; those 10, you pray Hail Mary's. Again you conclude the decade by saying the 'Glory Be'; Glory be to the Father, etc, then the Angels prayer, 'O my Jesus', etc., and thus you have completed the first decade of a Rosary. Then you begin a second decade. Again you pray an 'Our Father'. Then you pray 10 Hail Mary's. Those Hail Mary's, in the case of the Joyful Mysteries will be the Visitation, where Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth. Again you conclude the decade or 10 Hail Mary's with a 'Glory Be' and then the 'O my Jesus', the angels prayer.

Again you pray another decade, another 10 'Hail Mary's', beginning with the 'Our Father' and saying 10 more Hail Mary's. In the Joyful Mysteries, those would be; you would think about the nativity when Jesus was born in Bethlehem. The Rosary is a Biblical prayer and you should think about the events in the Rosary which the decade signifies.

Following the third Joyful Mystery, again you pray the 'Glory Be' the angels prayer, and then you go to the fourth mystery. In this case, the fourth mystery would be the Presentation in the Temple. You begin with an 'Our Father', as always, you say 10 Hail Mary's, on the 10 next beads. You conclude the decade, again by saying the 'Glory Be', the angels prayer, and you are now ready for the fifth decade of the Joyful Mysteries.

You pray the 'Our Father', you pray 10 more Hail Mary's, and then you conclude with the 'Glory Be', and the angels prayer. The fifth Joyful Mystery would be Jesus is lost and found again in the temple. So now you have said 50 Hail Mary's, 5 'Our Fathers', the Apostles Creed,

which began the Rosary and the intermittent prayers in between. Add at the end: 'Hail Holy Queen' prayer and the 'St Michael' prayers, and that is one complete Rosary.

You should really pray four Rosaries in a day, and each of the mysteries depict incidents in Jesus life. The second set of mysteries are the Luminous Mysteries, the third set are the Sorrowful Mysteries and finally you finish with the Glorious Mysteries. Now if you are just beginning Mega Man, I would advise you not to pray the whole Rosary. This is a spiritual exercise, and just like when you exercise your body you start slowly. In fact I would say just one Hail Mary the first day, and then maybe after a couple of days, say a decade which would be 10 Hail Mary's. Maybe by the end of the week or a couple of weeks you could try an entire Rosary and sometimes you can split up the Rosary; say a couple of decades in the morning, a couple of decades in the afternoon and so on.


Personally I try, I don't always succeed, I try to get in all four mysteries of the Rosary. I believe the reason we have four mysteries is because that is an End Times number. For almost a thousand years there were only three mysteries, but Pope John Paul II added the fourth set or Luminous Mysteries.

So that concludes my teaching on the Rosary. I hope you found this interesting Megaman. This was for you. The Lord told me to do this video for you. So I hope you start praying the Rosary and I hope everyone in my audience does also. This is the weapon, Mary's Rosary is the weapon which will defeat the Antichrist, along with Mary's scapular.

HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

The Rosary is made up of "decades". A decade is one "Our Father" followed by ten "Hail Marys" and a "Glory Be". Whilst it is usual to say five decades at a time, it is better to say one decade well, rather than five decades badly.

Begin with the sign of the cross. Pray the "Apostles Creed" holding the crucifix and continue on the straight piece of the Rosary with one Our Father, three Hail Marys and a Glory Be as shown in the picture. Then to start the first decade, pray one Our Father. Moving onto the circular piece of the Rosary, continue with ten Hail Marys and finish the first decade with one Glory Be and the "Fatima Prayer". By saying five decades of the Rosary, you will complete one full circuit of the beads. To finish after completing your chosen number of decades, pray the "Hail Holy Queen". The prayer to "St Michael Archangel" and the "Memorare" are very powerful extra prayers. As you say each decade, think about a story in the life of Mary & Jesus. There are twenty stories to think about. Each story is called a "Mystery". On the next pages you will be able to follow the five "Joyful" mysteries, the "Mysteries of Light", the five "Sorrowful" and five "Glorious Mysteries".



PRAYERS OF THE ROSARY

THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

In the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Maty, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; He descended into hell.

On the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. *Amen.*

OUR FATHER

The Rosary is such a tremendously powerful weapon against Satan, that armed with the Rosary in our hearts, and the beads in our hands, we can even stop wars. If we only knew how powerful this prayer is – we would never want to put the beads down.
