God Put Out the Lights on Trump Pt 2



Last week on Tuesday,
President Donald Trump
held a meeting at the
White House and he
explained what he meant
in Helsinki when he
seemed to imply that he
had more faith in Vladimir
Putin than he did in our
Intelligence agencies. And
it's interesting when he
