## Bible Prophecy: Trump Will Pick a Godly Justice!

Next week our president, Mr. Donald J Trump, will perform his most important action to date; and that is he will nominate someone to the Supreme Court of the United States. Up until now all of his actions have been relatively minor because they have been executive orders which are not nearly as important as the Supreme Court because his nominee could affect life in America for 20 years. And we will look at verses 20 and 25 of line four; we haven't looked at those yet, and verse 9 of life five and, believe it or not, these are all about Mr. Trump appointing a pro-lifer, someone who is against abortion, to the Supreme Court. And I'm sure our Lord planned it so I would cover those verses on this program.

So let's first look at verse number 20: 'Assemble yourselves and come and draw near together, you that are saved of the Gentiles'. Now, who would that be? That would be you and I and Isaiah is saying here that we must unite behind Donald Trump. 'They have no knowledge (that is the Gentiles) that set up the wood of their graven

work, and pray to a god that cannot save.' Well, who would that god be? The first god I thought of was Allah; and it's certainly true that the Muslims, for the most part, did not support Donald Trump. Let's move ahead to verse number 25: 'Therefore shall he (that's Donald Trump) say in the Lord are my justices and empire:' This is talking about the justices of the Supreme Court. Now, some Bibles, instead of 'justices and empire', have 'righteousness and strength'. It means the same thing but obviously 'justices' is much better and in the Latin it's 'justicia' and I'm sure St. Jerome was inspired by the Holy Spirit to use that word because this is a prophecy to the United States and that's why 'justicia' is so close to 'justice' in the English language. This is talking about Mr. Donald Trump's appointment next week; he must fulfill this prophecy or he is not prefigured by King Cyrus in chapter 45.

Now, if Donald Trump's 'empire' is also in the Lord that means that he's going to place America once again under Almighty God; one nation under God. 'They shall come to him (the Gentiles) and all that resist him shall be confounded.' Well, now who are going to be confounded by Donald Trump's appointment to the Supreme Court? When the Supreme Court fortyfour years ago took away the right to life from the Bill of Rights here in America, they took away the most fundamental of all of our rights.
